We are passionate about making changes, to ensure our impact on the environment is a positive one. We want to reinforce our intentions, and that's why we're implementing our own Green Promise. We vow to do our bit to help save the environment, and we encourage our valued guests to get on board and help us achieve this. Here's our promise to you:



Our carbon footprint is recorded annually and each year we plan how to reduce and offset this. Our aim is to improve our sustainability year on year.



Our staff are all trained to implement our environmental policies whilst at work, and we encourage them to take these policies home and into the community. Solidarity between our hotel and our staff strengthens our efforts. Therefore we hold regular meetings to discuss how each department can improve their environmental impact, with open discussions and idea sharing.

Our monthly water consumption is recorded, and we will strive to find ways to reduce this.

We encourage our guests to reuse their towels and linens, with signs in each of our rooms instructing them how to request a change of sheets/linens when required.

Our cleaning products and toiletries all have an internationally recognized eco-label

We sort our waste and recycle where possible. Our waste levels are monitored and we are continuously planning how to reduce, reuse and recycle more of it. We invite our guests to also recycle their waste and have separated bins for them to do so.

Where single-use items must be used, we use biodegradable alternatives when possible.

Over 75% of all our lightbulbs throughout the hotel have energy efficient bulbs.



We employ staff in all positions without discrimination by age, gender, race, religion, disability, socio-economic status, etc.



All our employees are paid at least a living wage, so the salaries are not below the legal minimum salary. Our rooms are fitted with a key activation system for the electricity. The A/C units automatically switch off when the balcony doors are opened.



All office electronics (computers, printers, screens, etc.) are energy efficient with automatic energysaving mode and switch off in periods of non-use.



Where possible, we purchase organic, locallysourced and/or fair trade ingredients to be used in our kitchen. We also endeavour to use seasonal ingredients, use less meat and take into consideration animal welfare when purchasing ingredients.



At every meal in our restaurants, we offer a vegetarian and/or vegan dish.

Plastic bottles used are 100% recyclable or replaced by glass bottles where possible.

All of our bedrooms are non-smoking bedrooms.



Our hotel has accessible bedrooms and ramp access to the grounds



We support our local community and arrange community events, with the purpose of improving our local environment.



We recommend our guests visit the local natural, historic and cultural sights, and encourage them to use green transport (bus routes, bicycles, walking).



We have reduced the use of paper where possible, using online tools and when unavoidable, printing on recycled paper, on both sides and re-using scrap.
